AP Students Score Better With Tutor.com

A case study of Red Clay Consolidated School District

Many school districts are asking students to take more rigorous coursework—including Advanced Placement (AP) and International Baccalaureate (IB) classes—and looking for effective ways to support students with the courses and exams. One successful model for advanced student achievement is the AP program at Red Clay Consolidated School District in Wilmington, DE. The district encourages its students to pursue AP courses and provides one-to-one online tutoring from Tutor.com to increase students' content understanding and applications, as well as exam scores.
